As the year comes to an end, we have our district and area conventions where members run for office and apply for various awards at the state level. Finally in June, the Freestone County Fair rounds out the year that is hectic and fun all at the sametime. Fairfield FFA usually has multiple entries in all the shows at the Fair each year. 


## Teague Students Show Off Floral Design Skills



is a time for FFA members to raise awareness about the role the National FFA Organization plays in the development of agriculture's future leaders and the importance of agricultural education.




